SACRAMENTS

Infant Baptism: Normally celebrated on a Saturday at 3:00 p.m. Baptisms also may be celebrated during Holy Mass (except during Holy Week). Please contact Jennifer Strash (757-898-5570) to schedule. Parents are required to complete a Baptismal Preparation session prior to a Baptism; these are presented on the first weekend of January, March, May, July, September and November following the 11:30 a.m. Mass. Session dates may be adjusted due to holidays. Session dates and location will be posted in the bulletin.

Confirmation: This Sacrament fortifies us in the power of the Holy Spirit for a full experience of human living. Confirmation is conferred normatively upon teens in their sophomore year or through the OCI process for all those, children or adults, who are converting into the fullness of the Catholic faith. Sincere preparation must precede the reception of this beautiful Sacrament.

Anointing of the Sick: The Sacrament of the sick may be received after weekday or weekend Masses with prior notice. The Sacrament may also be celebrated in the Parish Office or with a personal visit to a home or care facility.

Sacrament of Marriage: Couples called to the Sacrament of Marriage should contact the Parish Office at least 6 months prior to the desired wedding date. Please make no firm arrangements until after meeting with the Deacon/Priest.

The question has been asked and we thought that we would share the answer with all because maybe others have the same question.

How much does it cost the parish for leaf removal?

\$0. The landscape team ministry is responsible for this task. The landscape team comes together to blow leaves into the woods. No leaves are taken to the compost facility. It is a long seasonal process because leaves are falling throughout autumn and into the New Year. There is no final leaf blowing effort because we are leaf blowing throughout all seasons. The landscape team takes care of all landscaping chores except for mowing the grass from March 15 to October 15.

Thank you, Thomas Montgomery (St. Joan of Arc parishioner) for your leadership to plan, organize, and execute a new paver walkway to the landscape shed as your project for Eagle Scout. Tom developed a design to lead people into the shed reusing the gray concrete pavers in the Piazza. This will eliminate people walking through the mud to get into the shed for items needed. The walkway is stable and very much appreciated by all who need to get into the shed. Thank you, Tom for your leadership and attention to all of the details.
